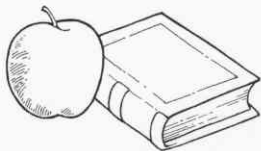
**Center Preparation**

Students working in this center will benefit from information provided on a project board background, chart pad, or poster. The information will aid those who need help learning the appropriate mathematical terms of measurement as well as the names of the tools of measurement. The names and pictures of the tools depend on what is placed in the center. Following are examples of measurement terms that may be needed:

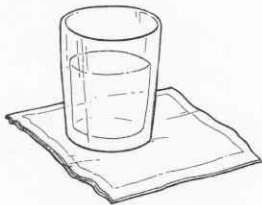
length	width	height	weight	cups

Include pictures of objects described in several ways. Examples follow:

The book is 6 inches wide and  $8 \frac{1}{2}$  inches long. It is 2 inches tall. The book weighs one pound.



The apple is 4 inches tall and weighs 6 ounces. The circumference is 8 inches.



The glass is 6 inches tall and will hold 5 ounces of liquid. The circumference of the glass is 11 inches.
