Bunnicula by Deborah and James Howe

- Complete an activity from the Unit Vocabulary Sheet.
 Read *Bunnicula*.
 Complete 3 activities in a row (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal.) If you choose to complete the center box FIRST, then you may select **any** other 2 activities to complete. Check them as you complete each one.

Chester uncovers some clues that lead him to believe that Bunnicula is a vampire. List all the clues in order as they appear in the story. Look at each clue carefully and write your opinion as to whether Chester interpreted these clues correctly or not.

VL

Chester exhibited some unusual behavior for a cat. Imagine that the Monroes bring Chester to you, Dr. Kit E. Katz, a famous cat psychiatrist, for help. Make a medical record for Chester in which you list his behavior, your diagnosis and prognosis and how you plan to counsel Chester.

VL

Create a "Hare Hop" dance or game. Write directions and teach others. If you created a dance, research to find out about the "Bunny Hop" dance that was popular in days gone by. Compare the two dances. If you created a game, compare it with an old favorite "Hopscotch."

MR

Calculate the costs of owning a rabbit. Be sure to include such things as food, veterinarian fees, etc. Don't guess — research!

LM

Write a review of the book. First give author information, then list and describe characters. Summarize the story and write recommendations, substantiated with excerpts from the story.

Inter

Imagine a scenario in which Chester and Bunnicula are left on your doorstep with a note asking you to take good care of them. Write a short story telling how you feel about and interact with your new pets.

Intra

Make a story mobile. Include the title and author as well as the main characters.

VS

Create a "Bunnicula" board game, write instructions and share with others.

What Chester, Harold and Bunnicula ate played an important part in the story and was not always what is recommended for animals. Research to find appropriate food for these three types of animals. Compile a healthy diet plan for each. Include daily food items and amounts.
